



## INFECTIOUS DISEASE PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PLAN

### Policies and Procedures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

- Implementation of an Infectious Disease and Prevention Plan.
- Learn to Sail programs for ages 9 and under are postponed until further notice.
- Maximum wind limits will be adjusted by skill level to minimize capsize and recovery.
- Student to Instructor ratio no greater than 5:1 will be maintained.
- Each class of 8-10 kids and 2 instructors will have their own shaded classroom space.
- Classes will be color coded; campers will have a colored wrist band.
- Boats will be assigned per group and will not be rotated.
- All equipment will be numbered/color coded and assigned.
- All times for docking, launching, lunch, and bathrooms will be staggered to allow for appropriate physical (social) distancing.
- Wetsuits and life jackets must go home with the camper(s) and cleaned accordingly. There will be no life jackets or wetsuits to borrow.
- Classes will be separately maintained on shore (i.e., no intermingling of groups).
- The same 8-10 kids and 2 instructors will be together for the 3 week duration of the camp.
- Lunch will be eaten in each class's designated outdoor area.
- Classes will not sail near each other and will not share the same race course or drills..
- Everyone is required to wear a face covering at all times while on shore or if speaking to a coach in close proximity while on the water. A neck Buff is recommended for sailors.
- A distance of 6 FT will be maintained at all times; the facility will be marked to help campers and instructors maintain a 6ft distance while sitting in the classroom, rigging, launching or waiting for the bathrooms.
- SYC's on-water safety practices remain unchanged. Instructors will put water safety ahead of COVID-19 prevention measures as appropriate.
- Additional hand washing and hand sanitizing stations will be placed around the facility.
- Daily cleaning and sanitization of all high touch areas including equipment, surfaces, and restrooms will take place daily; campers and instructors will be asked to wipe down high touch areas i.e., bathroom door handles) before entering and upon exiting.
- Signage for physical (social) distancing protocols, hand washing, and face coverings will be placed around the facility.
- Only instructors, staff and sailors will be permitted to enter the facility.
- Drop-off / Pick Up will be in the SYC parking lot. Parents are not permitted to leave their vehicle. Parents must take their sailors' temperature each day before attending camp. This will be logged each day by a camp instructor.
  - Students are required to arrive changed and ready to sail.
