

## **SYC Youth Sailing**

### **Isolation Plan & Response to Breaking Protocol**

#### **Isolation Plan**

- In the instance of a sailor showing symptoms of COVID-19 while at SYC
  - Instructor will move sailor to Isolation Area in Dining Room.
  - Instructor will call parent once sailor is confined to the Isolation Area.
  - Parent instructed to pickup child immediately (no more than 1 hour away)
  - Instructor will wait with individual from a distance, keeping sailor in view and keeping others at a distance.
  - All parents within symptomatic child's class are notified via email by end of day (5pm).
  - Once child is escorted off-site by their parent, Instructor will wipe down isolation area and group area immediately..

#### **Response Plan to Breaking Safety Practices**

- While we recognize this is a youth program, it is imperative that we adhere to the Safety Practices to ensure that our staff and community remain safe. Our staff will be teaching and showing the participants how to follow the practices. In the chance that someone is not following the safety practices, we have laid out our response here. There are two types of infractions regarding Sailor/Parent Code of Conduct, and Code of Safety Practices: Minor vs. Major
- Minor Infraction Examples
  - Accidentally breaking social distancing rules
  - Not wearing mask/buff on SYC premises
  - Accidentally entering SYC tool shed, unassigned areas, and office
- Minor Infraction Response:
  - Sailors requested verbally to adhere to Sailor Code of Conduct more than 3 times will be asked to leave for the day. If a sailor repeats the action the following day, they will be removed from the class and unable to attend. This is

for the safety of all campers, staff, club members and the community. And to ensure SYC can remain operational.

- Parents will be notified via email for minor infractions of Code of Safety Practices at the end of day.
- Major Infraction Examples
  - Arriving at SYC with COVID-19 symptoms.
  - Purposely ignoring Instructor/Coach instructions related to Covid protocols.
- Major Infraction Response:
  - Parent will be contacted and child will be removed from the class.
